We write on behalf of our client, Fadi Elsalameen. On February 6, 2018, my colleague, Scott Gilbert, copied here, entered a notice of appearance as counsel, attached hereto, in Mr. Elsalameen's case filed in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia (the "Court") against the Bank of Palestine, P.L.C. (the "Bank").

On October 10, 2016, Mr. Elsalameen submitted to the office of Legal Assistance to Foreign Countries, through counsel, the attached request for service of process on the Bank of the civil complaint in the above action in accordance with the Hague Convention on the Service Abroad of Judicial and Extrajudicial Documents in Civil or Commercial Matters.

On August 30, 2017, you informed Mr. Elsalameen's previous counsel in the attached correspondence that the documents were sent by registered mail to the Bank, but that no delivery confirmation had been received.

We have been ordered to provide the Court with a status report on or before February 28, 2018, regarding the service of the complaint against the Bank. Accordingly, we would greatly appreciate an update from you regarding the status of service. In particular, please let us know whether the Bank has returned the receipt confirming delivery, and any further steps you have taken or plan to take in connection with service of process in this matter.
